Campus update- HS

David McBride provided an update on Rochester Prep High School, highlighting quarterly results and USI inspection feedback. Laura Wilkinson detailed activities of the RIT Partnership and provided an overview of the HS's enrollment.

Uncommon Annual Report

Brett Peiser gave an overview of the five year Strategic Plan for Uncommon, with the overarching goal of Achieve, Expand, and Impact). He also talked about the Home Office survey and detailed the largest challenge around teacher recruitment in Rochester. Mr. Peiser then took questions from the board members.

AMD Update

Paul Powell presented Rochester Prep elementary and middle school academic results which included data on quarter two assessments and STEP data. Mr. Powell also provided an overview of the recent USI inspections.

Facility Update

Anna Hall gave an overview of facilities. Rochester Prep will plan to open the 3rd elementary school. The auction was won for 305 Andrews and Uncommon will begin renovations as soon as possible with the plan to occupy the space this fall, 2016. The renovations of the building at 432 Chili Avenue are going according to schedule and within budget. Ms. Hall also noted that Uncommon is still in conversation to purchase school 36 from the City of Rochester, but that we would likely not occupy the building in the fall, 2016. Ms. Hall then detailed that the High School would start to occupy the 2nd floor at 175 Martin Street starting next fall.

Financial Update

Ron Zarella provided an update on Q2 finances noting that enrollment has been consistent, and being understaffed has resulted in an increase of our budgeted surplus.
