Whereas the True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School (TNRP) has leased, on a triple net lease basis, school building real estate from True North St. Jacob Street, LLC at 85 St. Jacob Street in Rochester, NY;

Whereas TNRP entered into this lease with the understanding that the cost of building upgrades were ultimately to be shouldered by TNRP;

Whereas the school building is in need of significant refurbishment;

Whereas TNRP wishes to complete one stage of the modernization plan for 85 St. Jacob Street over the course of the summer recess period in 2017;

Whereas TNRP has secured a \$100,000 grant from the Max and Marian Farash Charitable Foundation that can be used to support the desired modernization plan;

Whereas TNRP has received a New York State Charter School Stimulus Fund grant that will reimburse \$200,000 in capital outlays for Rochester Preparatory Charter School 3, which is located at 85 St. Jacob Street;

Whereas TNRP is projected to have \$74,089 available from its 2016/2017 fiscal year operating surplus;

Whereas TNRP has a lease agreement with True North St. Jacob Street, LLC that provides TNRP with a purchase option for the 85 St. Jacob Street facility for the amount of the then outstanding mortgage balance on the building plus relevant transaction costs; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School (TNRP) should:

- 1. direct True North St. Jacob Street, LLC to execute the desired building improvements at 85 St. Jacob St. during the 2017 summer recess period and agree to pay the True North St. Jacob Street, LLC a sum of \$374,089 for these renovations; and
- 2. authorize Geoffrey Rosenberger, Chairman of the TNRP Board of Trustees, to negotiate and execute the relevant amendment to the 85 St. Jacob Street building lease to effectuate this resolution.

Whereas TNRP has received a New York State Charter School Stimulus Fund grant that will reimburse \$200,000 in capital outlays for True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School - West Campus;

Whereas TNRP is projected to have \$175,000 available from its 2016/2017 fiscal year operating surplus;

Whereas TNRP has a lease agreement with True North Andrews Street, LLC that provides TNRP with a purchase option for the 305 Andrews Street facility for the amount of the then outstanding mortgage balance on the building plus relevant transaction costs; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that True North Rochester Preparatory Charter School (TNRP) should:

- 1. direct True North Andrews Street, LLC to execute the desired building improvements at 305 Andrews Street during the summer of 2017 and agree to pay the True North Andrews Street, LLC a sum of \$475,000 for these renovations; and
- 2. authorize Geoffrey Rosenberger, Chairman of the TNRP Board of Trustees, to negotiate and execute the relevant amendment to the 305 Andrews Street building lease to effectuate this resolution.
